Downtown's **HISTORIC EAST VILLAGE** offers an eclectic blend of historic buildings, hip eateries, boutiques and a wide variety of other retail establishments. For a bit of culture, character and funky charm, take a day to shop and dine in the Historic East Village. On the edge of the Historic East Village sits the lowa State Capitol, and nestled along the river is the Brenton Skating Plaza offering outdoor ice skating with a skyline view.
