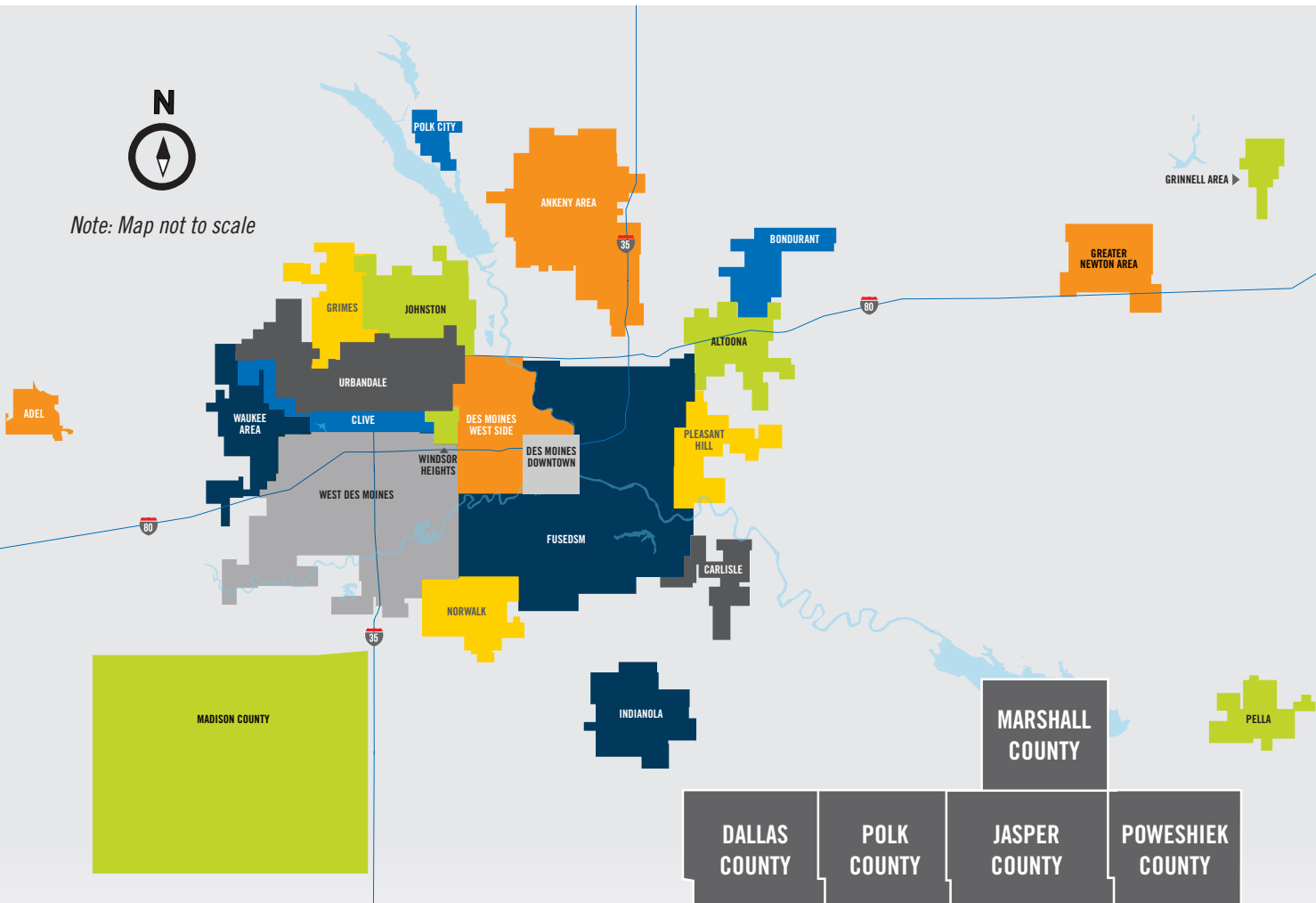


GREATER DES MOINES PARTNERSHIP

FASTEST-GROWING METRO IN THE MIDWEST:

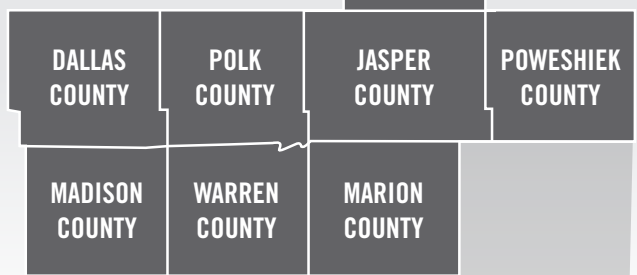
Population in The Partnership's service area has grown by 9 percent.
