lowa has **nine times the national average** of people working in the ag and feedstock chemicals sectors.







### HIGHLY SPECIALIZED, HIGHLY EDUCATED WORKFORCE



Enjoy access to a regional labor market of more than one million people, 200,000 of which are employed in ag and bioscience.



60,000 students attend lowa's public and private universities, with 35% of the region's workforce having attained a bachelor's degree or higher.

lowa's R&D expenditures for bioscience are 12% higher than the national average.

Strategically located in the middle of the country at the crossroads of major interstates and rail networks, the Corridor boasts the nation's most advanced agbioscience-related distribution network.



lowa's business-friendly environment produces nationally competitive incentive packages for qualifying projects. The State of Iowa has provided more than \$260M in workforce training and \$85M in direct financial assistance to more than 200 bioscience projects since 2006.
