 - c. You were in a leadership opportunity or had a project you were most proud of.
- 4. Can we go over your resume?
- 5. What are your career goals and where do you see yourself in the next 5 years?

- 1. Why are you interested in this internship?
- 2. What do you know about our organization?
- 3. What is our mission statement?
