GOAL: 1 MILLION

The Greater Des Moines Combined Statistical Area (CSA) population has grown to more than 940,000, and is on pace to reach one million.

\$51 BILLION

The Greater Des Moines MSA GDP grew by \$51 Billion from 2001-2023, representing growth of 227%, outpacing the U.S. GDP growth of 156% in the same period.

Greater Des Moines ranked first among our Midwestern peers for growth, 20% above number 2, Omaha.


IMPACT

Investors, Affiliate Chambers and Regional Chamber Members empower The Partnership's work to build a growing, dynamic and future focused region.


